Select magazines and journals:

- Publications from Russia/USSR/former Soviet states
- Publications from the U.S. and other countries with featured content pertaining to Russia, USSR, former Soviet states

Other printed matter (These items must be in very good condition)

- Postcards, advertisements, posters, photographs, etc., 20th century and earlier, with historical relevance to Russia, USSR, former Soviet states.

What Not to Donate:

Video, DVDs, CDs, cassette and 8-track tapes; encyclopedias; technical manuals; professional texts; textbooks.
